



## Fundraising Ideas to make your Tea Party a success!

**Hold a Bake Sale** – Encourage as many people as you can to contribute cakes, biscuits and healthy alternatives, donating the proceeds to Antibiotic Research UK.

**Hold a Raffle** – Hold a raffle to win prizes (ask for donations from those involved or ask for donations/discounts/vouchers from local businesses). Even raffle off the leftover cakes!

**Antibiotics Fact Quiz** – If you're holding your tea party at school or college, run an Antibiotic's Fact Quiz as part of your event and encourage people to enter in teams.

**Book, plant, or bric-a-brac sale** – Have your colleagues, friends or family contribute their old paperbacks and hold a book sale or perhaps even a plant or bric-a-brac sale to raise a few extra pounds.

**Guess the 'baby' competition** – Ask everyone in the department/team/club to bring a photo of themselves as babies, display their photos and ask people to guess their identities. Charge 50p per play and if they get them all correct, they win a slice of cake!

**Sponsored sporting activities** – Ask people whether they would like to take part in a sponsored walk, cycle or run as part of the event and work off all those calories!

**Promise Auction** - Persuade friends and colleagues to donate their skills and services for auction. Lessons in sport, music, dancing or languages; home-baked cakes and meals; ironing and other household chores.
