- The completed Research Grant Application Form section must not exceed six sides of A4, excluding the CV of the lead applicant.
- The font size must be no smaller than 10 point and use Arial type.
- The application must be filled in using a word processor. No handwritten applications will be accepted
- The application must be received by the published deadline date no later than 5.00pm (UK time).
- The applicant must be working for a United Kingdom based organisation.
- Maximum sum applied to be no greater than total sum of £9,000 to be spent over one year. Research awards can only be applied to laboratory costs/consumables, etc, and not to staffing or travel costs.
- Grant applications are welcome from all areas of research into antibiotic resistance, although the charity currently has an interest in prioritising research into complex/chronic urinary tract infections and related diagnostics.

All completed applications must be submitted to **grants@antibioticresearch.org.uk** with a full CV of the lead applicant. Applicants will be informed by 31 August 2023 at the latest whether or not their application has been successful. No discussions will be entered into if an application is not funded.
